- Detailed assessment of current and anticipated shortages and mismatches
- Clear methodology, also to monitor evolution
- Feed into the European Skills Panorama

Sectoral Skills strategy

- Based on an overall growth strategy for the sector
- Priorities for addressing gaps
- Digitalisation, key enabling technologies, transition to circular economy
- Activities, milestones and well-defined outcomes – Do not forget the "Who"

Vocational training content and qualifications

- Revise/update occupational profiles (ESCO)
- Revise/update qualifications and certificates
- Develop training content:
 - i-VET (including higher VET)
 - c-VET
- Work-based learning, mobility integrated in curricula
